

UTW- As scientists we will be...

- Exploring a variety of natural materials including what they feel and look like. Discuss what they are called and where we might find them/where they come from. Encouraging the children to talk about anything they notice about them including similarities and differences between them.

UTW- As historians and geographers, we will...

- Look at the clothes and the houses that Grandma and the three bears live in. How have houses changed? Are they similar or different to the houses we live in?
- Focus on the postman in 'The Jolly Postman' how does he travel around? How might he travel around now? How does he help us? (Continuing to focus on showing interest in different occupations).
- Story settings in familiar and traditional tales -know that some environments are different to where we live.

Using our computing skills, we will be ...

- Using the class interactive whiteboard, taking photographs and using the school ipads.

In phonics we will be learning...

- Phase 1 - following the Bug Club Phonics Scheme.

In Physical Development we will be ...

- Using one-handed tools and equipment
- Exploring agility, space and movement (following the Striver scheme).

Literacy- As writers we will be ...

- Developing mark-making and pencil control in different ways such as: Drawing wanted posters, creating simple story maps, drawing items for Red Riding Hood's basket.
- Continuing to develop our ability to write our names by tracing initially to develop control and become familiar with the letters/formation.
- Continuing to give meaning to the marks we make.

Maths- As mathematicians we will be learning ...

- Number 1**- Subitising, Counting, Numeral
- Number 2**- Subitising, dice pattern, Subitising random pattern, Subitising -different sizes, Counting
- Pattern**- Extend AB Colour patterns, Extend AB Outdoor Patterns, AB Movement Patterns
- Fix my Pattern**, Extend ABC Colour patterns, Extend ABC Outdoor Patterns
