Thank you to everyone who has generously supported the School Council Christmas Trolley over the past two weeks.


All monies raised by this event will go towards the purchase of new playground equipment.

This will take place at St. Paul's church on Tuesday 19th December at 10 am. KS2 parents and family members are invited to join us and to participate in the carol singing.




Before and After School Clubs

Councillors will meet on Monday to discuss the success of the Christmas Trolley and to continue to work on their mental health and wellbeing campaign.


Performing Arts Showcase
