Reminders for the New School Term

Please remember that children are only allowed to wear simple stud ear-rings and a watch to school. On a games or PE day it would be helpful if your child does not wear their earrings to school. If they do have their earrings in, they need to be able to take them out themselves. If they are either unable to as they have just been pierced or cannot take them out by themselves, please send them in with some medical tape to place over the earrings.

P.E. Kits

Children are asked to come to school dressed in their Games kit on their P.E. days. Class teachers will inform you on what day(s) P.E. is. We ask that children leave their pumps in school in a small carrier or pump bag for indoor P.E. Please label all items of clothing, including pumps and coats. Please do not purchase P.E. kit with logos, it is an unnecessary expense - the school P.E. kit is a plain white t-shirt with plain black or navy-blue jogging bottoms / shorts, which can be purchased cheaply from supermarkets.

Parking

Please can parents/carers remember to park considerately on the car park and ensure that cars are parked in the designated bays only. Do not stop and drop off at the front of the school office. Please do not park in disabled bays unless you are a blue badge holder. Highwood car park also has a one-way clockwise system - please could you ensure that you follow this to prevent any accidents.

European Day of Languages

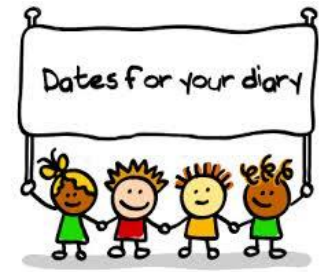
We will be participating in European Languages Day on 26th September 2024. Please see the end of the newsletter for further information about this event.
