In Healthy Relationships Education we will be exploring ...

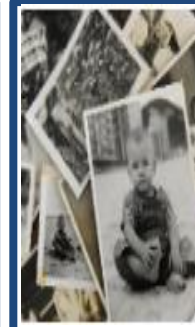
- Friendships- Making friends
