As Artists we will be ...

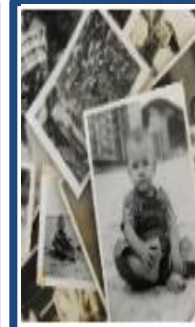
- Creating different lines and shapes.
