As Technologists we will be ...

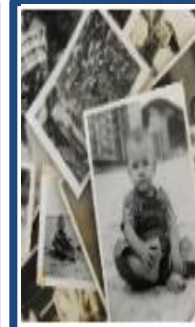
- Exploring where different foods come from.
