<p>The funding received from Pupil Premium has been allocated in the following ways:</p> <p>An extra teacher (0.6) for Y3 / Y4 classes so that Maths and English lessons can be delivered to smaller groups to ensure more progress during these years.</p> <p>This is a gateway for all Pupil Premium children to pass through and benefit from.</p> <p>We have provided a TA for all Y1 and Y2 PP children to provide 1/1 support in areas of need, this is in addition to the above. Y5/6 children receive relevant interventions in small groups or 1/1.</p>

Measuring the impact of PPG support 2013/14
<p>The school will evaluate the impact on each identified pupil at the end of each term in Pupil Progress meetings with staff. Evaluation will focus on progress made against pupil targets and the effectiveness of closing any gaps between performance and age related expectations.</p> <p>We will report the impact of PPG at the end of the academic year.</p>
