Children currently in Y3,4,& 5 who are continuing the same instrument next year (woodwind, brass & violins) may keep their instrument at home to practise.

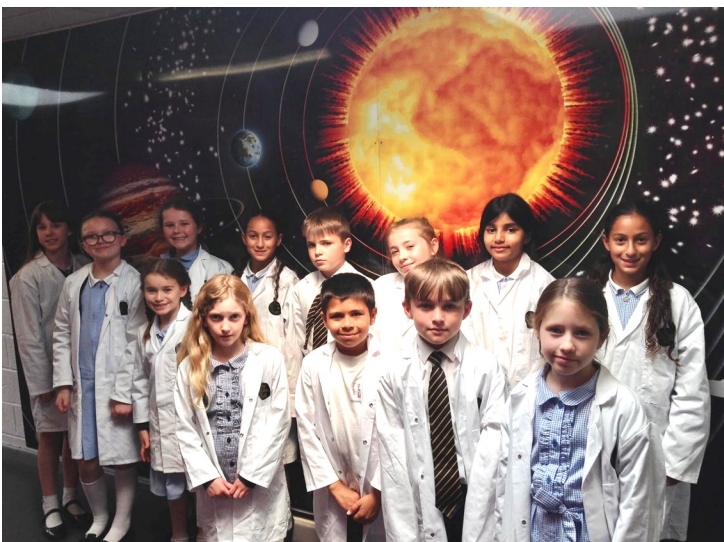
Covid 19
